

**RULES OF PRACTICE  
OF THE  
22<sup>ND</sup> JUDICIAL CIRCUIT  
McHENRY COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

The Circuit Judges of the 22<sup>nd</sup> Judicial Circuit, McHenry County, Illinois, hereby adopt the following Rule of Practice:

**SUPPLEMENTARY PROCEEDINGS**

1.     **CITATIONS:**           In addition to the requirements set forth in 735 ILCS 5/2-1402 and Supreme Court Rule 277, the following rules of court apply to Citation Proceedings:

(a)     Upon completion of the examination of any respondent served with a citation, an order shall be entered dismissing the citation unless the court determines that it is necessary to continue the citation. There shall not be more than one continuance of any citation unless good cause is shown. Orders continuing a citation must set forth specifically the reason for the continuance and what is required to complete the citation. Continuances merely to permit a judgment debtor to complete an installment payment agreement or order or otherwise satisfy the judgment will not constitute good cause and will not be allowed. Orders compelling a judgment debtor to make payments to be applied to the judgment must provide that the underlying citation is dismissed.

2.     **RULES TO SHOW CAUSE:**

(a)     When a respondent fails to appear or comply with a court's order, the court may issue a rule to show cause to determine if the respondent is in contempt of court. After proper service of the Rule to Show Cause, only one continuance of a rule shall be allowed. Any further continuances shall be for good cause only as determined by the court. The fact that a judgment debtor is making payments shall not be considered good cause for a continuance of the rule.

(b) Unserved rules may not be continued after a third alias is returned unserved. If the third alias is returned unserved, the supplementary proceeding will be dismissed with leave to reinstate upon showing that the service can likely be obtained. The first, second and third alias rules shall be returnable approximately 30 days from the date each rule is issued.

The undersigned Circuit Judges of the 22<sup>ND</sup> Judicial Circuit, McHenry County, Illinois, constituting a majority of the Circuit Judges in said Circuit, and pursuant to the authority vested in them by Rule 21(a) of the Rules of the Illinois Supreme Court and by Section 1-104(b) of the Illinois Code of Civil Procedure (735 ILCS 5/104(b)), do hereby adopt this Rule in regard to **SUPPLEMENTARY PROCEEDINGS** as a Rule of Practice of the 22<sup>ND</sup> Judicial Circuit, McHenry County, Illinois, on January 10, 2008, with an effective date of April 1, 2008;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to Rule 1.01(g) of the Rules of Practice of the 22<sup>ND</sup> Judicial Circuit, McHenry County, Illinois, the Chair of the Local Rules and Procedures Committee of the 22<sup>ND</sup> Judicial Circuit, is designated to assign the Official Part and Section number to the Rule adopted herein.
