

2010 MAJOR PERMIT CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

THE FOLLOWING DEVELOPER/PERMIT PROJECTS ARE CURRENTLY OR WILL BE UNDER CONSTRUCTION ON COUNTY HIGHWAYS IN McHENRY COUNTY IN 2010. THESE PROJECTS ARE BUILT BY THE DEVELOPER/PERMITTEE AND THEIR CONTRACTOR AT THE EXPENSE OF THE DEVELOPER/PERMITTEE, AS A RESULT OF COMMERCIAL, RESIDENTIAL OR MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS. AGAIN THESE ARE PERMIT PROJECTS BEING CONSTRUCTED AND PAID FOR BY EITHER A DEVELOPER OR A MUNICIPALITY, NOT McHENRY COUNTY.

BASED ON WEATHER CONDITIONS AND UNFORESEEN CONSTRUCTION, WEATHER OR UTILITY DELAYS, THE FOLLOWING ANTICIPATED DATES FOR START AND COMPLETION OF PERMIT PROJECTS COULD CHANGE. DATES ARE APPROXIMATE ONLY. MOTORISTS SHOULD ALWAYS USE CAUTION AND STAY ALERT IN THESE CONSTRUCTION AREAS.

THESE PROJECTS ARE SEPARATE FROM AND SHOULD NOT BE CONFUSED WITH COUNTY BUILT PROJECTS.

- **Cary Road**

This is a project by the Village of Cary for construction of a **shared use path** (bikepath) along the westerly side of Cary Road, from Fox Trails North to Main Street and includes removal of existing trees and installation of new storm drain. Motorists should expect occasional lane closures on Cary Road during construction. This project is anticipated to be completed in June 2010. - **Lake Cook Road**

This is a project by a developer of property on the westerly side of Route 62 to reconfigure Lake Cook Road, east of Route 62 **to add a westbound through lane and relocate the existing westbound right-turn lane**. Motorists should expect occasional lane closures and lane shifts. Lake Cook Road near the intersection with Illinois Route 62 will be reduced down to one-lane for westbound traffic. This project is expected to start in May 2010. Any questions or comments about this project should be directed to the Village of Algonquin at 847-658-2700.

- **Pyott Road, south of Rakow Road**

This is a project for the Lake in the Hills Airport to **relocate/realign Pyott Road farther to the east** away from the airport runway. While the majority of the road work was completed in 2009, some work such as paving and punch list items remain. The work in 2010 includes the installation of final asphalt surface and pavement markings, shoulder work and final restoration. Temporary lane closures with flaggers will be posted as necessary during the construction. Motorists should expect occasional delays. Work is anticipated to be completed in June 2010. - **Randall Road, at Harnish Drive**

This is a developer built project to reconstruct Randall Road from north of County Line Road to just north of Harnish Drive as a result of the new large scale commercial development (approved by the Village of Algonquin) recently constructed at the southwest region of the intersection. Work includes the construction of a southbound right-turn lane on Randall Road at Harnish Drive, installation of the remaining street lights, guardrail and completion of restoration items. Work is expected to start in May of 2010. Motorists should expect occasional lane closures. - **Virginia Road, between Rakow Road and Pingree Road**

This is a project by Waste Management of Illinois to totally **reconstruct a section of Virginia Road in front of the site with a new pavement section and provide new turn lanes and access** to a proposed Waste Transfer Facility (approved by the City of Crystal Lake), located just northwesterly of Pingree Road. While the majority of the work is complete, some drainage and punch list items remain. Completion is anticipated by June 2010.
