Randall Road Widening Project to Resume, Construction anticipated to Start week of May 3, 2010

Final paving work on Randall Road will take place at the intersection of Harnish Drive beginning the week of May 3, 2010, weather permitting. The work will involve removal of the existing barrier wall, construction of storm drain, curb and a southbound right-turn lane, final paving of surface course and installation of additional roadway lighting and guardrail. The paving work is anticipated to begin the week of May 10 and be completed within a week. Pavement marking will then follow shortly after the paving is completed. The work is being undertaken by Algonquin Penny L.P. as part of required roadway improvements associated with the construction of the new Oakridge Court Shopping Center, located at the southwest corner of Randall Road and Harnish Drive in the Village of Algonquin.

During the project, southbound lane closures will be necessary to allow for the construction of the right-turn lane and for the paving and striping operations. Anticipated lane closures will be posted in advance on message boards located within the project area. Motorists should allow for extra travel time during this phase of the project.

The project is anticipated to be completed in May 2010 and is the final construction required for that portion of Randall Road related to that commercial development. Project updates will be posted to the McHenry County Division of Transportation website as necessary throughout the duration of the project.
