Boil Order remains in effect
Unincorporated McHenry

Woodstock IL – McHenry County Department of Health (MCDH) received notice today that the boil order issued for unincorporated McHenry on September 20th is still in effect, following water sampling completed by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). Residents impacted by the boil order who are served by the Eastwood Manor Water Company include homes bordering Route 120 (south), Chapel Hill Road (east), Lincoln Road (north) and Hillside Lane (west).

Residents are reminded not to drink the water without boiling it for 3 to 5 minutes prior to food preparation. Boiling kills bacteria and other organisms in the water. Bottled water should be used for drinking, making ice, brushing teeth and washing dishes. Residents should also disconnect water sources such as ice makers.
