Illinois EPA lifts boil order for unincorporated McHenry

Woodstock IL – McHenry County Department of Health (MCDH) has received notice that the boil order issued for unincorporated McHenry on September 20th has been lifted by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). Unacceptable chlorine residuals caused residents to boil their water before preparing food and to use bottled water for drinking, washing dishes and brushing teeth. Residents impacted by the boil order are served by the Eastwood Manor Water Company and includes homes bordering Route 120 (south), Chapel Hill Road (east), Lincoln Road (north) and Hillside Lane (west).

Illinois EPA and MCDH will continue to work with area residents and businesses during the recovery phase to assist in the return to normal service operations.
