

# Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Online Courses McHenry County Medical Reserve Corps (MRC)

One of the goals of the MRC is to provide its members with training before an emergency occurs. To this end, as a McHenry County MRC Member, you are **required** to take the following online courses:

- IS-700.a National Incident Management System (NIMS), an Introduction**

★ When you have finished studying the materials, click on "Take Final Exam". Follow the prompts and submit your test answers.

★ You will receive an e-mail confirmation message upon your successful completion of a course (this may go into your "Junk" e-mail).
