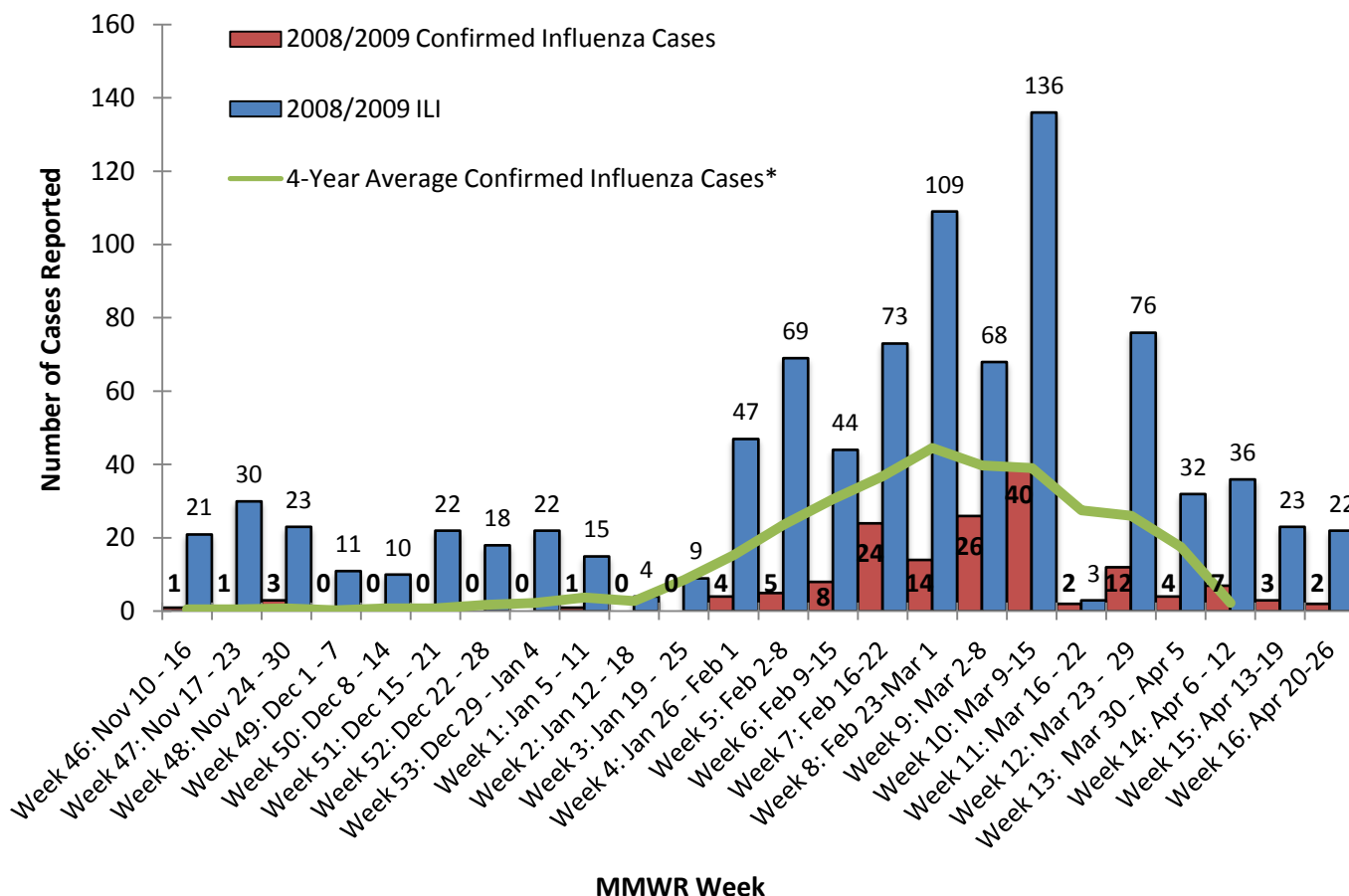


McHenry County Department of Health 2008/2009 Influenza Activity Surveillance

The McHenry County Department of Health conducts surveillance for Influenza every year. Several healthcare sites from around the County including hospitals, urgent care centers, and physician offices are participating by reporting the number of laboratory confirmed Influenza cases and the number of Influenza-like-illnesses (ILI) seen at their facility each week. Influenza-like-illness is defined as any person presenting with fever greater than or equal to 100 °F (37.8 °C) oral or equivalent AND cough and/or sore throat (in the absence of a known cause).
