MCRide is a great way to get around McHenry County. Whether you need transportation for work, school, shopping, or visiting a friend, MCRide provides an affordable and stress-free way to travel.

Simply call the Call Center at **800-451-4599** the day before you need a ride and let them know your pick-up and drop-off location, along with your desired pick-up or drop-off time. If you are a Senior 60 years or older, or someone with a disability, you will receive a discounted fare.

When your scheduled pick-up time arrives, meet the MCRide bus at the curb and enjoy the trip to your destination. MCRide is a shared-ride service, so you may even meet a new friend along the way!



## How Much is a Ride?

MCRide is a distance-based fare structure.

Base Fare	First 5 Miles	Each Additional Mile
General Public	\$2.00	\$0.25
Senior (60+)	\$1.00	\$0.25
Individual with a Disability	\$1.00	\$0.25

For example: A 7-mile one-way trip from Woodstock to Crystal Lake will cost \$2.50 for the general public.

- For Everyone, schedule your trip 24 hours ahead
- For Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities, schedule your trip up to 7 days ahead

## When Can I Ride?

<b>Monday - Friday</b>	<b>6:00 AM - 7:00 PM</b>
<b>Saturday</b>	<b>9:00 AM - 5:00 PM</b>
<b>Sunday</b>	<b>No Service</b>

## What Else Should I Know?

- All vehicles are wheelchair accessible
- This is a shared-ride service so the bus will pick up and drop off other passengers
- This is a curb-to-curb service and drivers cannot escort riders outside of the vehicle or carry packages
- Up to two children, 7 years or younger, ride free per fare paying adult



### Are you a Senior who lives in McHenry Township?

You qualify to use the **McHenry Township Senior Express**, which provides door-to-door transportation services for seniors.

- Operates Monday - Friday, 8:00 AM - 3:00 PM
- Register once with the Township at 815-385-5605
- Call the Pace Call Center 800-451-4599 to schedule a ride at least 24 hours in advance
- Only \$1 per ride for each one-way trip within the service areas of: 60050, 60051, 60097, 60072, Centegra Medical Centers, and McHenry Community Health Center
